## Lockwood Pedestrian Safety District Advisory Board

- **No public Comment**
- **Present** Nic Talmark, Carlotta Hecker, Stephani Williams(new board member). Board members absent: Brandy Dangerfield, Woody Woods. Guest: Interstate Engineering, Jonathan McNiven from Yellowstone County News) Patrick Klugman from BSED, Jeffrey Butts.
- **Jonathan McNiven** discussed what he is doing with the web page Lockwoodmontana.com. He gave a presentation to LSPD about having its own web page which he would update as needed. This would help Lockwood residents know what is going on with the LSPD and post minutes of each meeting. The cost is \$200.00 the first year and this includes the web site set up and hosting and then it is \$150.00 each year thereafter. Nic indicated that we will need to run this past the Commissioners as we are the Advisory Board and now post information on the Yellowstone County Website. Nic will contact the Commissioners on this issue.
- **Nic introduced Stephani Williams** and she said she lived in Lockwood years ago, moved away and now is back and wants to be involved with the safety of Lockwood.
- **Interstate Engineering was introduced and gave an update on the grant.** He is pursuing more information as the grant is now in the hands of MDT and he was not sure if they will use in house consultants to do this project or hire outside Consultants.
  - He is going to Helena to meet with Ryan from MDT and let MDT know if it goes to outside Engineering their company is interested. He also brought up two task orders, however, there was not a quorum so the issues were tabled. Nie suggested a special meeting and it was scheduled for March 16th at 6 pm and all members would be contacted to see if they can make it so the task orders can be voted on.
  - It was suggested Carlotta contact Bill Kennedy to get an update on what is happening with the Grant however a letter was sent out from MDT on March 4, 2016 indicating the 12 selected projects applications are being forwarded to Montana Transportation Commission for approval at their March 24, 2016 meeting. Once approved by the Commission, MDT will draft a project agreements outlining the financial, project development and maintenance requirements for the project. Mr. Dahlke said he expected to see the project agreement in Early April and indicated in the letter Mr. Kenney's efforts in advancing this candidate project would ensure the needs to the Lockwood community would be better met. Carlotta discussed with Nie after the letter was received that contact with Mr. Kennedy will not occur until after the approval of the Montana Transportation Commission approval to get an update.
- **There is a Growth Policy meeting** on March 3, 2016 at the Fire Station for a further update.
- **Grasshopper Lawn and Sprinkler Service** sent a letter to Carlotta indicating interest in the snow removal for the side walk. Nie had a copy of the agreement which will be forwarded to Grasshopper Lawn and Sprinkler Service so they can bid on 2017 snow removal as the Lockwood School has the contract for this year.
- **Agenda items for next regularly scheduled** meeting will be the Bike Walk to school in May and FRP for side walk cleaning.
