1. Public Comment

2. Update on Rapid flashing light on Hwy 87/Old Hardin Road. It should be going up shortly weather permitting. Issues of patent questions answered and approved so installation will occur shortly.

3. Task Order 7-Old Hardin Rd project-US Highway 87 to Piccolo. Going out to bid, prebid scheduled for April 25, 2018 with opening of bids on May 1, 2018 and should start within 3 weeks. It is hoped it will be completed this year, linear feet less than 4,000 or about 3/4 of a mile when completed. It will be a 6' wide concrete sidewalk with 6" of concrete for depth, there will be a culvert used to enclose the irrigation ditch it passes over.

4. Becraft Lane sidewalk-TA project is approved, scope of work 75% completed, goal is to have 90% of scope of project done mid-May and then it will be submitted to MDT. County will need to speak to one individual whose fence is in the right of way and also has a shed in the right of way.

5. Snow removal. Grasshopper Lawn and Sprinklers has not been removing the snow off the side walk built over the past two years, no one knows who has but we need to have the County request a RFP from interested parties as the linear footage will continue to grow and we need it kept clean. At this time there is 1500 feet of sidewalk and by this fall there will be an additional 1,000 feet by 18/19.

TEDD/Billings ByPass: Someone brought up the possibility of a boat ramp being added when the new bridge is put in to cross the Yellowstone. This is not part of the path across the Yellowstone Bridge Project we support but will need to be pursued by others. Woody reported the Advisory Group for the TEDD will attempt to meet monthly, there was not much progress at last meeting and not much to do until the TEDD starts to generate money to work with.

6. Consultants reports:

- A. sidewalk usage numbers passed out.
- B. Bike/Walk to school in May.
- C. Informational booth at Big Sky EDA on April 20th, anyone interested let Nic know.
- D. Everyone on Board review our list of Old Priorities and report back one that have been done and new ones we might want to add.
- E. May want a community survey to see what Lockwood folks are thinking about and what they think of what has been accomplished so far.
